Surprisingly almost half of the attendees do not calibrate their equipment either because they do not feel the need to do so, or did not know that you could. Several members use **X-Rites' ColorMunki**. This is a fairly expensive product (\$377 from amazon.com), but there is a \$50 rebate available through June 30, 2010. By the way, many thanks to **Kathleen Brennan** for loaning us her ColorMunki to calibrate our projector; the color improvement is remarkable. Others use **Monaco X-Rite EZ Color/Optix XR Bundle** (\$149 used from amazon.com), **ColorVision Spyder 2** (\$189 from amazon.com), **ColorEyes Display Pro** (\$175 from [Integrated Color](http://IntegratedColor.com); software only but will work with compatible hardware). One member has had very good results using the services of [Profiles By Rick](http://ProfilesByRick.com) (\$25 for RGB Color Profile; \$15 for Advanced B&W Profile). [Monitor Calibration Wizard](http://MonitorCalibrationWizard.com) is a free program that does not use any hardware.
