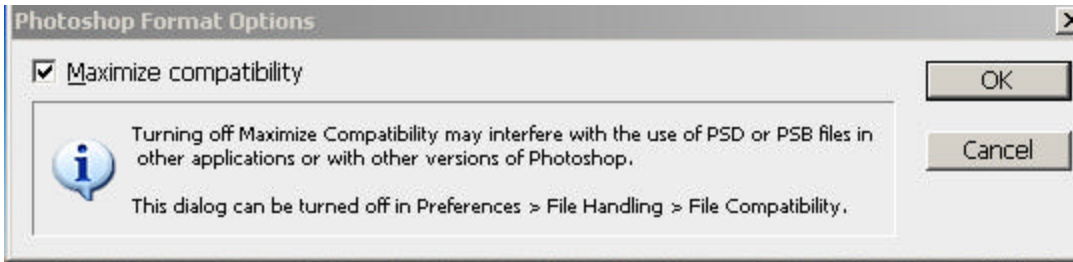


Turning Off Maximize Capability

When you try to save a psd file you may get this warning:



The only reason to do this would be so that someone with a pre-CS version of Photoshop could read your file. In general you probably do not want to do this because Photoshop will save a flatten version of the image along with the expanded version, thus taking up more memory space.

To deactivate this warning go to Preferences>File Handling and the Maximize PSD and PSB File Compatibility to “Never”.
