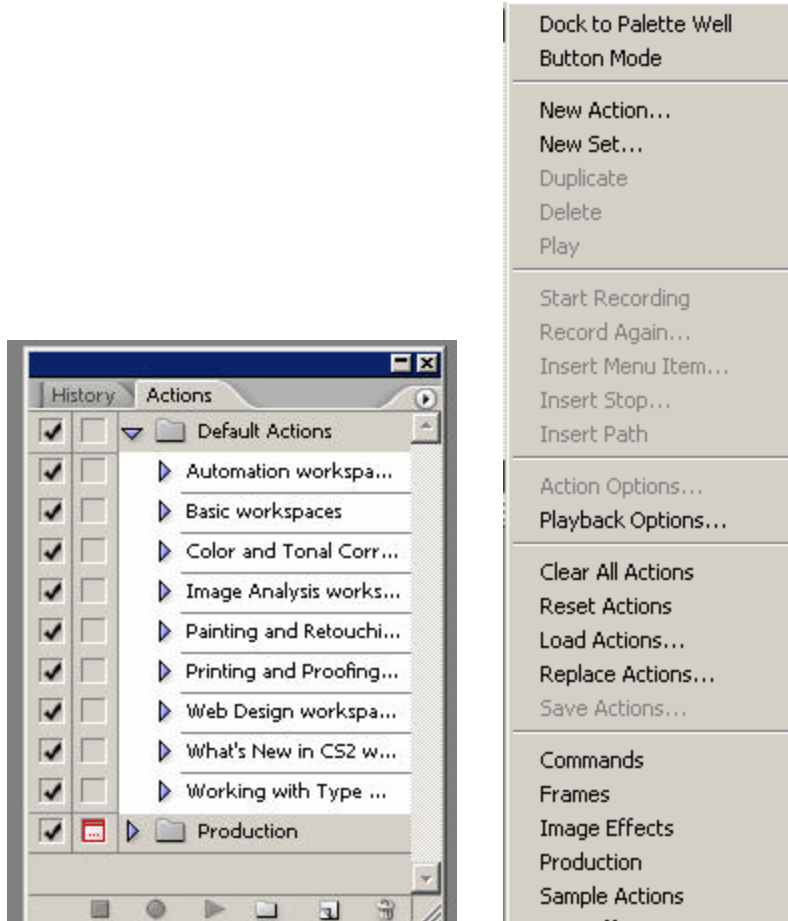


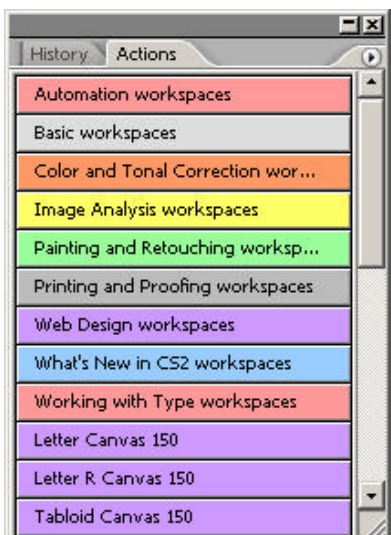
Modifying Actions Palette

Last month we talked about using Photoshop Actions to automate repetitive tasks.

That little small arrow at the top of the palette is one of the most important and probably the most over looked button in all of Photoshop. Clicking on this arrow button opens up a complete menu for the respective palette.



If you click on “Button Mode” the list of Actions will be converted the buttons which may make this palette easier to use. The colors of these buttons can be changed.



Clicking on the “Button Mode” change back to list form.

“Clear All Actions” will remove all actions from the palette.

“Reset Actions” will restore the list of actions.
